Prof. Nadia Chabane

Nadia Chabane is a Professor of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry with a PhD in neuroscience. She is full professor and head of the «Service des Troubles du Spectre de l'Autisme & apparentés» at the CHUV in Lausanne.
